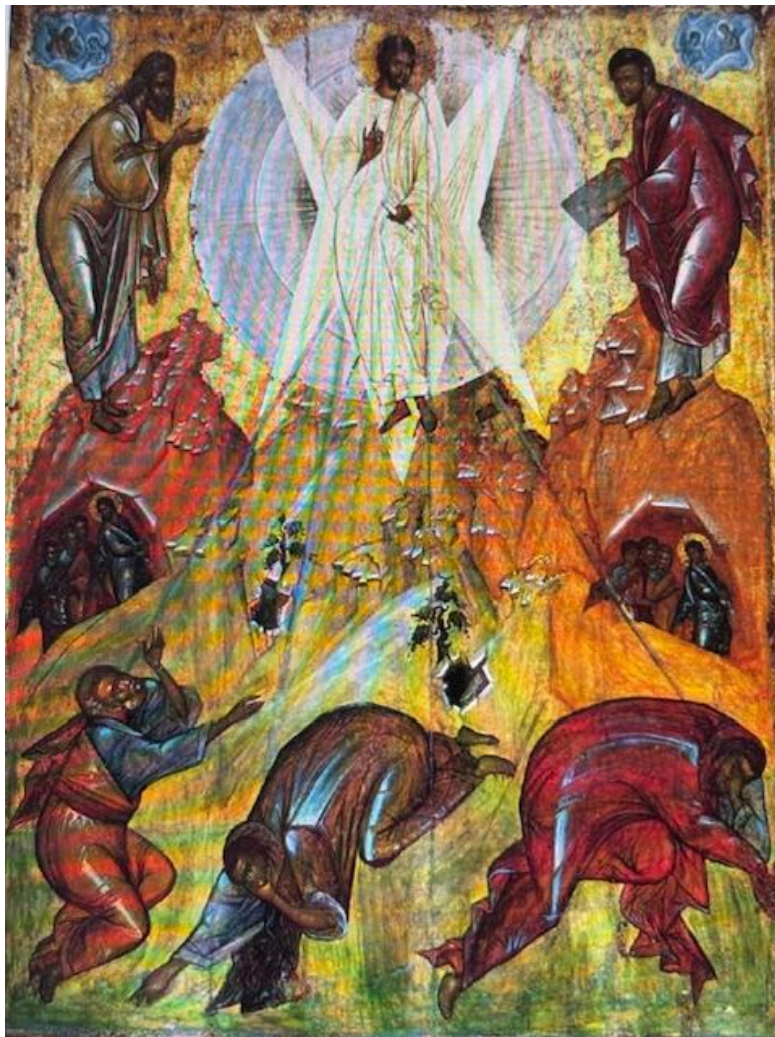

The Presbytery of Fife will meet in person on Saturday 21st February 2026 from 10.00am. The meeting will be held in Heart of Fife Church (St Margaret's), 228 Woodside Road, Glenrothes, KY7 5HD.

At this meeting the Presbytery will be asked to approve:

The Basis of Linking of the following Congregations -

- Ceres, Kemback and Springfield Church of Scotland l/w East Fife Rural Parish Church of Scotland (Carnbee, Kilrenny, Kingsbarns, Largoward)

The Presbytery hereby cites up to a maximum of 4 representatives of each congregation (in addition to the Minister/Interim Moderator and the Presbytery Commissioned Elder from the charge), to attend the meeting. The meeting will hopefully also be available via YouTube for anyone from the congregation wishing to join us remotely. Please note, however, the meeting is not a hybrid meeting therefore those watching remotely can only listen and observe proceedings.

It would be extremely helpful if you could notify the Presbytery Office by email how many representatives of your congregation are intending to attend the meeting. The Moderator will invite one member to speak if they so wish. This will be a maximum of five minutes in duration, and a warning bell will sound which will advise the speaker that they should conclude their remarks.
