Peace Garden



PHASE 1

- Specimen small trees & shrubs which are easily maintained and provide attractive colour throughout the year.
- Remembrance Meadow grassland left to grow long - some species planted into this - soil will be too rich for 'wildflowers' but select perennials which are similar to 'wildflowers' and will colonise the meadow. Opportunity for local families/ groups etc to plant spring bulbs in remembrance of loved ones etc.
- Circular/Labyrinth garden short cut grass path looping round to central space where gatherings/bible meetings etc can occur. Seating in place. Border planted along either side of the path to define path. In the border 'something' to represent the various stations on The Pilgrims' Way.
- Nuttery a mixture of hazelnut, cobnuts, filberts, walnut. A traditional and productive space for harvestable nuts providing sustenance to pilgrims and the community.
- Bunded Bank this bank will defend the garden against flood water from winter flooding as burn rises. This will contain the garden removing the need for fencing - hedging can be planted along the top of the bank if necessary.
